**1ST ANNUAL BLACK CATHOLIC HISTORY MONTH
POSTER AND ESSAY CONTEST NOVEMBER 2018**

Sponsored by The Knights Of Columbus #1774

The goal of the contest was to encourage learning about the rich history of the Catholic Church through illustrating and writing by students with help from their families. On July 24, 1990, the National Black Catholic Clergy Caucus of the United States designated November as Black Catholic History Month to celebrate this long history and proud heritage of Black Catholics. The Knights of Columbus encouraged students to research Black Catholic Christians with their families and learn about this heritage. We encouraged students to enter the poster or essay contest to demonstrate the knowledge they have gained from the research.

The contest was open to the children of the parish and the students at the Lock Haven Catholic School. Students in grades k-2 were encouraged to create a poster illustrating a prominent Black Catholic. Students in grades 3-5 were encouraged to write a 100-word essay and Students in 6-8 were encouraged to write a 300-word essay. Four members of our parish volunteered to be judges. The winning students were awarded a certificate and gift card for The Bus Stops Here. The judges and Knights were very impressed with the quality of the entries! We want to thank all of the students, judges, and Knights for their hard work. Competition was very high and there were several ties! The Knights plan to hold the contest again in November 2019!
