Patrick Madrid has written a whole slew of interesting books including Pope Fiction: Answers to 30 Myths and Misconceptions about the Papacy and A Pocket Guide to Purgatory. **150 Bible Verses Every Catholic Should Know** was endorsed in 2008 by the Vicar General Reverend Joseph R. Binzer of Cincinnati. For many Catholics, it is hard to know where to start when picking up the Holy Bible. You have to start somewhere, but it can seem so daunting. This slim volume selects key passages and organizes them along particular themes such as The Sacraments, The Communion of Saints, and The Sanctity of Human Life. The author says it is not meant to be a work of apologetics (defending the Faith). His goal is to help us deepen our faith, become more familiar with scripture, and "connect the dots" between scripture and our Doctrine. A nice read. ★★★★★
