## Featured Saint

**St. Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556)**  
**Country: Spain**  
**Feast Date: July 31**



One of 13 children of a northern Spain family, young Ignatius dreamed of love, knighthood, and doing great deeds. After being seriously wounded in a battle against the French, he was forced to spend a long period of time recuperating from the wound. During that time, he read the life of Christ and the lives of the saints, subsequently turning his entire life over to the search for God. Through rigorous prayer, fasting, sacraments, and penance, Ignatius found the peace he was seeking, eventually founding the Society of Jesus, or the Jesuits. The Jesuits were centered on the essential foundations of Christianity - the Trinity, Christ, and the Eucharist. Jesuits were to be guided by a true love of the Church and unconditional obedience to the Holy Father. The *Spiritual Exercises*, a form of prayer developed by Ignatius, remains to this day one of the hallmarks of Christian devotion and meditation.
