**Life Line Screening is coming to Holy Spirit Parish on Thursday, March 23, 2023.** Life Line Screening goes beyond regular checkups to look inside your arteries for signs of plaque build-up.

They will do four screenings: Carotid Artery Disease (CAD), Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD), Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA), and Atrial Fibrillation (AFib), **for a special pricing of \$149.**

## Cemetery Regulations

To avoid misunderstandings, it has been suggested that we publish the regulations governing our cemeteries. This is the first part:

*In the very earliest days, Mother Church found it necessary to make rules and regulations which would protect the sacred places and the relics laid therein. She could not and would not allow anything within the holy precincts which would desecrate them, lessen their beauty, or bring dishonor on the dead.*

*To ensure the sacred character of parish cemeteries in the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown, each cemetery is governed by the Pastor relying on the Cemetery's Rules and Regulations, the Canon Law of the Roman Catholic Church, and applicable Directives issued by the Bishop of the Diocese. Copies of both the Rules and Regulations and the Diocesan Directives are available for review in the Parish Office. Except where stipulated below, the Diocesan Rules and Regulations apply in all things pertaining to the operation of our cemeteries.*

*Ours is a Catholic Cemetery operated for the interment of those entitled to Christian burial according to the guidelines of the Roman Catholic Church. When one purchases a Burial Privilege Certificate, he or she and heirs bind themselves to the governing principles mentioned above currently in effect, or as amended in the future. Violation of these principles may result in the forfeiture of one's privilege to use the burial plot.*

## Featured Saint Saint Veronica



Legend states that as Jesus was being led to Calvary, his face dripping with sweat and blood, St. Veronica, a bystander, was moved with compassion. She walked out into the street with the struggling Jesus and offered him a cloth, likely her veil, which he accepted and used to wipe his badly marred face. Veronica's act is memorialized in the depiction of the Sixth Station of the Cross. Scripture does not speak of Veronica either before or after her act of kindness. We do not know when she was born or died. She is literally lost to history. However, the cloth may exist today, kept safe at St. Peter's in Rome. *Catholic News Agency*
