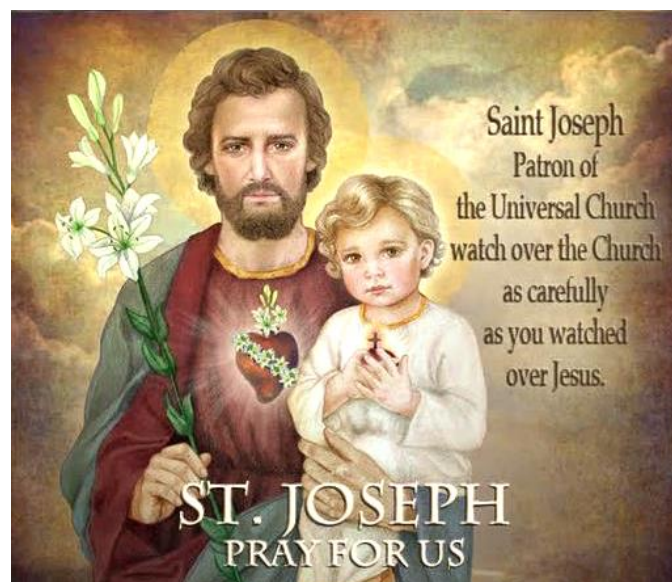

## Cemetery Regulations Part 2

To avoid misunderstandings, it has been suggested that we publish the regulations governing our cemeteries. This is the second part:

### **BUYERS' RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. *The purchase of a Burial Privilege Certificate, whether in a grave or a crypt, does not acquire title to the property itself.*
2. *Plots or graves are for family use; they may not be sold for profit by holders of Burial Privilege Certificates.*
3. *Plot holders are to keep Holy Spirit Parish informed of their current address. The address on file will be considered the legal address for notices pertaining to the cemetery plot.*
4. *In the event of the death of a plot holder, all privileges in the plot shall pass to the spouse; then to those named or designated in instructions left for the cemetery or in the will; then to those chosen by a joint decision of the legal heirs; finally, to those designated according to the Pennsylvania law of intestacy. A new Burial Privilege Certificate is to be issued in all instances by Holy Spirit Parish.*
5. *Holy Spirit Parish may, at its discretion, repurchase plots, graves, or crypts at original cost minus any outstanding expenses. Any transfer of ownership rights must be made by Holy Spirit Parish.*
6. *All Cemetery Rules and Regulations apply also to mausoleums.*
7. *Holy Spirit Parish reserves the right to make improvements to the cemetery at all times.*
8. *In all matters not herein specifically covered, Holy Spirit Parish shall have the right to determine and decide any and all questions that shall arise.*
9. *All inquiries and business concerning the cemetery are to be made in writing or by appointment only.*
10. *Perpetual care includes filling in sunken graves, seeding, cutting grass, and trimming around memorials. Care does not include placement, maintenance or repair of any monuments or the planting of flowers or ornamental plants on specific plots.*

## Garden of Gethsemane



The Garden of Gethsemane, referred to in all four Gospels, was the place where Jesus retreated to in deep prayer and fearful anxiety after the Last Supper, overwhelmed by the terror which he was going to encounter the next day. Translated from Greek, Gethsemane means "oil press" referring to such a structure located in a grove of olive trees, a short distance from Jerusalem's walls. On this night Jesus went to Gethsemane with his close friends Peter, James and John, asking them to sit close by as he wrestled with agony and sorrow over his impending fate. Throughout the night Jesus prayed relentlessly to the Father, seeking a reprieve from his sorrow, though not a reprieve from God's will which Jesus was committed to. Realizing that Peter, James, and John were unable to remain awake and keep watch during the ordeal added to the isolation, alienation, and betrayal Jesus was feeling. The arrival of an angry and unruly crowd led by Judas set in motion the final hours of the life of Jesus on this earth. Gethsemane provided the backdrop for Jesus modeling the correct way to behave in times of distress and anguish – **to be on guard, to not succumb to temptation, to face even difficulties we would rather avoid by turning to the Father and not to ourselves.**
